Legislation – The current legal duty to undertake an assessment is spread over three pieces of legislation: the NHS and Community Care Act 1990, the Chronically Sick and Disabled Persons Act 1970 and the Disabled Persons (Services, Consultation and Representation) Act 1986. Once an assessed need is identified we have a duty to meet that need. This needs viewing in the context of transforming Adult Social Care – more choice and control for people. With regard to Safeguarding and protecting Vulnerable Adults, The Mental Capacity Act 2005 provides the legal basis and framework for this across commissioned and in house SBC services and includes the important issue of Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards.
