I THINK THIS PUB SHOULD NOT BE ALLOWED MANY OF THE RESIDENTS INCLUDING MYSELF WORK AND THINK IT WOULD BE TOTALLY UNFAIR FOR A PUB TO BE OPEN ESPECIALLY TILL THESE TIMES. I MYSELF HAVE TO BE UP AT 5-30 ON A MORNING. IT IS ALREADY BAD ENOUGH HAVING MUSIC BANGING OUT FOR NORTON WORKING MENS CLUB TILL 11PM WHICH STRETCHES ACROSS THE TOP OF HOLLY ST. THE NOISE PEOPLE HAVE BEEN CALLED TO THESE PREMISES ON NUMEROUS OCCASSION FOR BEING

TO WOOD. WE ALREADY EXPERIENCE PEOPLE GOING HOME AFTER A NITE OUT ARGUEING, SHOOTING, SWEARING AND ON OCCASSIONS FIGHTING. I AS A RESIDENT THINK OPENING ANOTHER PUB WOULD ONLY ADD FUEL TO THE PROBLEM MAKE THINGS WORSE THAN THEY ARE NOW. WE HAVE HAD MANY INCIDENTS OF BROKEN WING MIRRORS, FLAT TYRES BANGING ON WINDOWS TO NAME A FEW. AS OUR DOORS AND WINDOW ARE NEAR THE FOOTPATH. IT IS ALSO NOT FAIR THAT SMALL CHILDREN ARE KEPT AWAKE BECAUSE OF NOISE WHEN THEY SHOULD BE SLEEPING WE WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO OPEN OUR WINDOWS BECAUSE OF NOISE + SHELLS OF SHOKING. THIS WOULD ALSO BRING MORE CARS AND TAXIS INTO THE ROAD WHICH IS ALREADY BADLEY CONGESTED AND I THINK IT WOULD BEEN DANGEROUS TO THE PUBLIC.

Re-Application 1 High Street-Norton

Dear Sir/Madam

I write on behalf of NORTON METHODIST CHURCH on Norton High Street in respect of your letter 13th January 2014 regarding the above licencing application and state that our immediate response is that we would not be in favour of supporting this application, for the following reasons.

- (1) In the past we have suffered vandalism to the church premises, which I am sure on some of the occasions can be attributed to the drunken behavior of individuals exiting the already numerous premises in the area which afford some irresponsible people the facility to consume and become highly intoxicated with alcohol into the early hours of the morning, and become mindless of their actions.
- (2) Because of the already limited car parking facilities in the area and with the church private car park being in close proximity to the proposed arrangements, it will tempt car users to overlap on to the church car park which has happened in the past thus restricting church members of that facility during special occasions ie Church Services, meetings, weddings and funerals.
- (3) Church members cars have been broken into on evenings when services and meetings are taking place and we

cannot totally dismiss that this may have been caused by people coming away from such licenced premises, who also have been known to express vulgarities towards myself and other church members, including Minister.

(4) Perhaps one of the worst and continuing atrocities which we are faced with is the litter which is spread on to the building and car park surfaces.

It's not unusual at times to find up to five or six broken, beer, wine, and cider bottles strewn around the car park in addition to cans which contain some kind of alcoholic beverage.

We also find cardboard containers with left over food i.e. chips, kebab meat, pizza etc left on the car park and garlic or other sauces splashed over church windows

Why do we object to this application?

Whilst I appreciate that you consider some of these issues not to be relevant to the applied licence, I strongly feel that as chairman of the church finance and property committee that it would be unwise of me as their representative to just sit back without registering our concerns.

I can assure you that we do not consider these objections simply on the basis of our being in business as a church, but clearly on the grounds that we have in the past suffered many disconcerting situations in the afore mentioned areas.

I HAVE 2 CONCERNS/OBJECTIONS AS WE HAVE A LONG-TERM TENANCY ARRANGEMENT.



2) AS WE ARE LOCATED DIRECTLY ABOVE THE APPLICANT'S ^{GROUND FLOOR} PREMISES, WE TAKE ISSUE AND OBJECT TO THE POSSIBILITIES OF NOISE LEVEL NUISANCES BEFORE THE TIME OF 8 PM. AS MENTIONED ABOVE, WE ARE A TEACHING/LEARNING CENTRE, AND SO NOISE ABATEMENT IS SOMETHING THAT WE WILL ACTIVELY ENFORCE - WE NEED ASSURANCES/GUARANTEES OF SOUND PROOFING/DEADENING AND WHAT LEVELS OF NOISE (IN dBA) MAY EMANATE THROUGH THE FLOORBOARDS, UPWARDS, AND EVEN THIS MAY NOT CONVINCE US ENTIRELY.
