The grounds of the representation is based on the following:

(Try to be as specific as possible and give examples of any evidence you may have e.g. on 1 June I could hear loud music from the premises between 10pm and 1.am. I am concerned that if the premises open until after 2am this will cause a nuisance to me and other residents of the street)

I have been regularly disturbed by the sound of the music from the keys music until 2am for the past 10 years (since The Powells took ownership of the club from the previous owner) In this time the nightclub has failed to adequately control the noise emitting from the ~~premise~~ premises, and I have had cause to contact the club on hundreds of nights because the noise of their music is preventing me from

sleeping. The noise is in the form of beats and bass, but also higher frequencies in fact, so that I can identify the song on many occasions.

The only relief I have had from this experience during the past 10 years, for any sustained period was approximately 7 years ago for a few months immediately before a planning application to extend the premises.

I have regularly reported this issue to SBC environmental health, and have warned the Keys that I will apply to licensing to review their licence, with legal representation so I am surprised that they are now pushing ahead to further extend their hours on any occasion, before ~~solving~~ solving their noise issues\*.
