PREVENTION OF CRIME AND DISORDER

1 CCTV equipment shall be maintained in good working order in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

- 1 Use appropriate management controls to reduce the likelihood of customers causing noise disturbance to local residents when using the premises.
- 2 The use of the rear yard of the premises should be limited to 23:00 to prevent noise nuisance affecting nearby premises.
- Any odours created from cooking on the premises shall be adequately vented and/or provided with odour control so that they do not cause a nuisance to nearby premises.
- There shall be provided at the premises containers for the storage and disposal of waste foods and other refuse from the premises. Those containers shall be constructed, maintained, and located so that access to them by vermin and unauthorised persons is prevented and arrangements shall be made for the regular lawful disposal of their contents.
- Where the premises provide food for consumption off the premises, the public area immediately surrounding the premise shall be cleared of waste food, food containers, wrapping etc at the end of trading on each day. Such refuse shall be placed in a container designed for the storage and disposal of refuse and waste foods which shall be constructed, maintained and located so that access to it by vermin and unauthorised persons is prevented and arrangements shall be made for the regular lawful disposal of their contents.
- 6 Have appropriate systems in place to control pest infestations, such as a pest control contract.

PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM

1 Unaccompanied children shall not be served after 21.00 hours.
