Environmental Health have been aware that this premises have been operating beyond their Licensing hours for some time now through complaints, monitoring checks and reports from other Responsible Authorities following previous notifications and warnings to the license holder.

This is having a detrimental effect upon residential properties in the vicinity not only from disturbance from customers late at night, but also pressurising other licensed premises that are compliant with their licensing conditions to extend their operating hours.
