Dispersal Arrangements [1]

- NHSE agreed with Primary Care Committee's recommendation that all patients remaining on the SHC register at 31 October would be classed as "vulnerable" and could therefore be allocated to an alternative practice;
- Seven practices with Hardwick & Roseworth Wards within their practice boundary;
- Met with Practice Managers & Cleveland LMC - 28 September



Dispersal Arrangements [2]

- All seven practices registering patients;
- Additional pump-prime funding allocated to practices in November and December;
- Additional Medicines Optimisation support into the 7 practices;
- Three practices identified as having capacity to take an allocation of patients following closure of SHC
